ORANGE COUNTY HEALTH CARE AGENCY HAS SUCCESSFULLY ENROLLED OVER 21,000 PATIENTS INTO THE MEDICAL SERVICES FOR INDIGENTS ONLINE ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION SYSTEM

NEWPORT BEACH, Calif., July 1, 2006 - NetChemistry, a top-tier provider of missioncritical, highly secure software to the Healthcare and Financial Services Sector, today announced that the Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA) has completed its first full year of web-based paperless enrollment and eligibility screening for Medical Services for Indigents (MSI).

"Since our launch on July 1, 2005 we have seen the quality and completeness of applications dramatically improve," said Chris Cruttenden, president of NetChemistry. "The paperless processing of all applications will be the new standard by which all medical services enrollment systems will be measured."

OCHCA MSI Program is a County run program serving approximately 21,000 eligible patients per year. MSI has a defined scope of services and eligibility criteria, serving adults 18 to 64 years old who have a current medical need, and no other financial resources to pay for those services. Eligibility in MSI is for 12 months at a time for the majority of its patients, with a select number receiving more than 12 months of coverage based on pre-determined medical criteria. MSI payments covers hospital, physician, pharmaceutical, home health, skilled nursing facility and durable medical equipment costs.

"How did we ever live with out it," said Dan Davis, MSI Program Manager. "This system creates accountability at each step of the process and is more than just an electronic application, it's an electronic determination system from beginning to end."
